



## District Awards

A Secret Selection Committee has been formed to receive endorsements from your Club Presidents. Article VI of the District 2-S3 Policies and Procedures manual provides detailed documentation of each award.

### **Endorsements:**

Documents must be prepared in the form of a resolution or in paragraph format. This endorsement is to be signed by both the Club President and Club Secretary. The Endorsement documents the candidate's years of service and outstanding achievements and is to be sent to the District Governor to arrive no later than 30 days prior to the District Convention. This year the District Convention is May 2, 2020. The Secret Selection Committee will determine the final decision of the award recipients. Previous recipients of an individual award are not eligible for the award a second time.

### **The following awards require an endorsement**

#### **Harry Reasonover Award**

The West Austin Lions Club presents the district's highest award for an individual, the Harry Reasonover Award. This award is also named for a delegate from the Austin Founder Lions Club that attended the first International Convention.

#### **Gold Spur**

The Gold Spur is awarded to a Lion member for outstanding service during the year the award is presented.

#### **Silver Spur**

The Silver Spur award is presented to a first year Lion member for outstanding service during the year presented.

The District Governor presents both the Gold Spur and the Silver Spur Award.

### **The following awards require no endorsement**

#### **C.W.A. MacCormack Award**

This is a CLUB award and is named for one of the delegates from the Austin Founder Lions Club who attended the first Lions Clubs Convention. It is presented by the Austin Founder Lions Club to the most active club based upon Monthly Membership Reports and Activity Reports.

#### **District 2-S3 Hall of Honor Award**

This is an individual award and is selected only by the District Governor. It is awarded to a member based upon service to the District. The recipient must have served on the Cabinet or District Committees for not less than five years and must be actively serving the District at the time of the selection.
