For the 12-month fiscal year that ended June 30, 2022, District 2-S3 has contributed \$11,665 to the Texas Lions Foundation for the 2021-22 Lions year. Your contributions accounted for 9.1% of the total amount received by the Foundation – that is OUTSTANDING and enables the Foundation to fulfill needs throughout the State. Forty-three of our Clubs qualified for 100% Club status by contributing at least \$2.00 per member to TLF. Lions of 2-S3, thank you for your continued support of your Foundation. YOU are making a difference in Texas.

Your Foundation continues to support local Texas Lions Clubs with Emergency Grants and Humanitarian Grants. This year \$43,000 was distributed in Disaster Relief Grants for Hurricane Nicholas, tornados, and wildfires throughout the state including \$3,000 to the Round Rock Lions Club for tornado relief. An additional \$41,887 was provided for several Humanitarian Grants for a grand total of \$84,887. Yes, it was a busy year for your Foundation.

Congratulations to IPDG Gayle Teggeman Collins. IPDG Gayle qualified for the prestigious Ed Flood Award by encouraging Clubs to contribute to their Foundation. The award will be presented in August at the Texas Lions Fellowship Banquet in Kerrville.
